She is the second of three girls, went to Catholic schools and was blessed with loving parents and incredible siblings and friends. She went to Spring Hill and then transferred to LSU where she obtained a degree in Landscape Architecture.

After her marriage, they moved to Covington, where she had spent summers as a child.
